- Minutes. The minutes of the December 7, 2021 meeting were presented. The
  motion was made by Dennis Hoot. and seconded by Gary Palousek to approve the

- 2. Public Comment Period. No one appeared, and no comments submitted.
- 3. Willacy County Drainage District No. 2 Regional Detention Facilities, Project Number 40088: Project Update. Engineer Isaac Huacuja did not submit a report.
- 4. May 7, 2022 Election. The motion was made by Dennis Hoot and seconded by J.T. Mayo to adopt this election order:

WHEREAS, in accordance with Acts 1969, 61st Leg., Reg. Sess., ch. 11, pgs. 31-40, codified as Section 6611, Texas Special District Local Laws Code, the Texas Water Code, and the Texas Election Code, Willacy County Drainage District No. 2 shall hold an election on the first Saturday in May of even-numbered years, at which time the required number of Directors shall be elected to fill the vacancies then occurring on the Board of Directors as provided by law;

WHEREAS, such an election is necessary and should be held on May 7, 2022, in order that two (2) Directors may be elected to membership on the Board of Directors of Willacy County Drainage District No. 1 to fill the place of two (2) Directors whose terms of office will expire on May 12, 2022;

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined and found that in accordance with standing order of this Board, written notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting, including consideration of the setting of said election, was posted at the District's Office at a place convenient to the public, and said notice was furnished to the County Clerk and posted by the County Clerk at the County Courthouse for the period of time and manner as is required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of Willacy County Drainage District No. 2 that:

be and it is hereby called and ordered to be held in and for this District, in the manner prescribed by law, on the first Saturday of May, 2022, the same being May 7, 2022.

Said election be conducted during the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. to seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. at the Farm Service Agency (FSA), 255 FM 3168, Suite 1, Raymondville, Texas, a place within the District and a place which the Board, after considering the requirements of Texas Election Code § 43.031, finds to be a proper place for conducting the election.
- 3. For the purpose of said election, all the area included within the boundaries of this District shall constitute one (1) election precinct.
- 4. Said election be held at the aforesaid voting place with the use of paper ballots.
- 5. The election shall be conducted by the following hereby designated and qualified officers:

- 7. The presiding judge designated for said election shall also serve as the early voting ballot judge and the presiding officer of said early voting ballot board, and shall appoint no less than two (2) other duly qualified members as provided by Texas Election Code Chapter 87.
- 8. Early voting shall be held as provided by law and shall be conducted by the following hereby designated and qualified officers:

- 9. Early voting by personal appearance for this said election shall be held at the same location the election is to be conducted as provided above, and said place of early voting shall remain open during the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) a.m. and five o'clock (5:00) p.m., which is at least nine (9) hours on each day of the early voting period, which shall begin on April 25, 2022, and continue through May 2, 2022, on each day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or official State holiday. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than April 26, 2022.

Such application must be signed by the candidate or by at least ten (10) qualified electors of this District. The first day to file an application for place on the ballot is January 19, 2022, and must be filed no later than five o'clock (5:00) p.m. on February 18, 2022, as required by law:

The Secretary of the Board of Directors shall conduct a drawing for the order in which names of the candidates for the above-mentioned election are to be printed on the ballot and shall post notice of the time and place of said drawing and mail notice of the date, hour, and place of the drawing to each candidate at the address stated on the application for a place on the ballot not later than the fourth (4th) day before the drawing in accordance with the terms and provisions of Section 52.094 of the Election Code.
- 13. Notice be given of this election by a method as prescribed by Section 4.003(1)(B) of the Texas Election Code.
- 14. A Writ of Election shall be delivered as prescribed by Section 4.007, Texas Election Code to the Presiding Judge no later than March 4, 2022.
- 15. Notice of this election be given as prescribed by Section 85.007(c) Texas Election Code, by posting continuously for at least seventy-two (72) hours preceding the first hour that early voting is conducted in the same manner Notices of Meeting of the Board are posted.
- 16. It is further found and determined that notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting was posted in accordance with the terms and provisions of Section 52.094(c) of the Election Code, and Section 551.043 of the Government Code for at least seventy-two (72) hours preceding the scheduled time of this meeting.
